GWR 'SILVERTON' SIGNAL BOX 7mm INTERNAL DETAILING KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

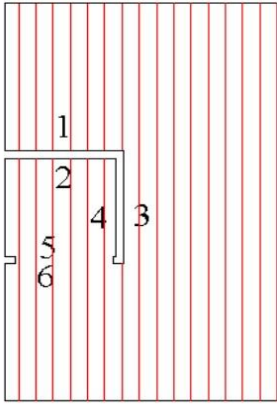
Warning: This kit is intended for those with a modicum of modelling experience and is not suitable for children due to small parts, the use of hazardous adhesives and sharp blades.

Please read through these instructions before starting construction.

Make up the internal floor support structure as shown. Note it goes one way round so that the supports avoid the end door. Don't glue the support structure to the walls yet.



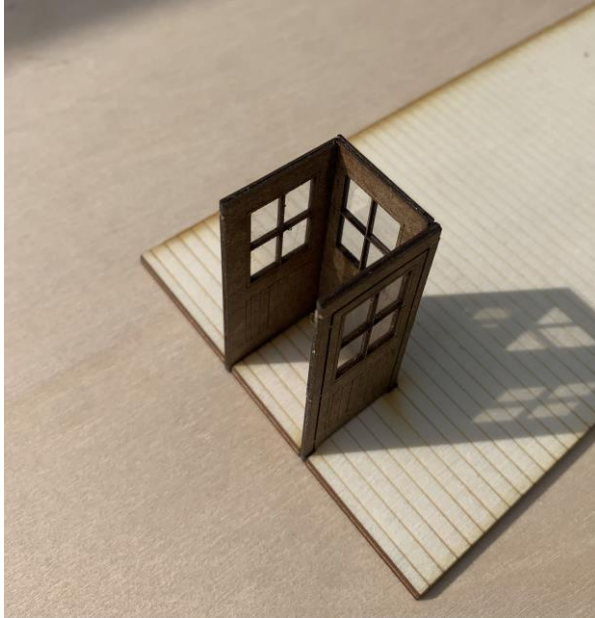
Make up the parts for the vestibule. These are numbered and correspond thus:



Laminate glazing to parts 2 and 4. Please note these are two different sizes. Laminate 1 and 3 to the reverse

Laminate 5 and 6 with glazing in between. Note 5 and 6 are handed. The door can be modelled in an open position by cutting through the glazing.

Fix to the floor as shown, flush on the underside.



And add the roof.



Next, fit the internal wall laminations, making sure the window and door openings accurately line up.



Also fit the internal door lamination.

Next fit the internal window laminations. These are best already painted and made up as complete internal and external window units.



Internal window sill strips are provided and will need cutting to length and fitting as shown.

NB. The illustrations above are all shown unpainted but I highly recommend painting the model during the various stages of construction. Eg, paint the walls and woodwork before adding the doors and windows and finally fitting the floor.

Prototype painting details for the period 1912-1947 and information can be found in 'Great Western Structure Colours' by Richard North.

Several parts are small and delicate and easily lost or broken. If you require replacements then simply identify the part by emailing a photo of it to me and send me a stamped, addressed envelope and I will post a replacement free of charge.
